

Self-Certification Scheme

The self-certification Scheme aims for making an entrepreneur a trust worthy and law abiding citizen who is willing to take care of all interests of the workers/ employees by following all the laws as applicable to create a friendly and safe environment and hearty relationship between the Employer and the Employees.

All the new enterprises in the State will be required to submit only self- certified documents online or manually. Further, GoHP has notified vide **No. Shram(F)1-1/2015 dated 12th May, 2017** that all Establishments/ Industry defined as new Start-ups under “Chief Minister’s Startup/ Innovation Projects/ New Industries Scheme” shall be under the low risk category.

- An applicant can apply online through the online Startup portal after logging in through credentials.
- This application is forwarded electronically to the concerned department official.
- Any discrepancy in the application shall be communicated to the applicant within 15 days from the receipt of application.
- In case, no discrepancy is communicated within stipulated time, the applicant shall be deemed to have been enrolled under the Self- certification scheme and no inspections will be done for three years without prior permission of Head of the Department.
- Once opted, the scheme shall be valid for three years. After the successful compliance under the Self- Certification scheme for three years, the employer or entrepreneur or occupier shall have option either to remain covered under the Self-Certification Scheme or opt out of the Scheme.
